FAQs

I thought only women who just had a baby could get free birth control?

Not anymore! Maryland has expanded its family planning (birth control) program. This new program now covers women who have never had a baby or who have older children.

I am a teen. Am I covered?

Yes. There is no minimum age for this program.

Do my parents have to know?

No! If you want don't want to tell your parents, you don't have to. Your provider can help you keep your information private. If you do not want information sent to your house you can have it sent to your provider.

What services are covered?

You will get counseling and a birth control method. The plan will also cover exams and follow up visits.

Which birth control methods are covered?

Almost any birth control method you can think of is covered. Pills, patches, rings, shots, implants, (IUDs) and permanent sterilization are all included. You and your medical provider can decide which method is best for you.

Can I go to any birth control provider?

Yes. You can go to any provider who accepts Medicaid in Baltimore City.

Do I have to be a US citizen or legal resident?

Yes. You must be a US citizen or legal resident and live in Maryland.

When can I enroll?

You can apply starting January 1, 2012. If you are eligible, in about 45 days you will get a card to take to your provider. You can receive services while you wait for your card.

What if I still have questions?

You can call any one of the clinics listed on the front of this card. You can also contact the Maryland Medical Assistance Helpline at 1-800-456-8900 and ask about the Family Planning Program.
