About The Job: Roberta's House is a non-profit grief and loss center that provides supportive services to children and families. The HOPE Project is one of the many programs that Roberta's House offers to the community. Their goal is to support women who have experienced a fetal or infant loss.

The FSW duties include, but are not limited to: Serve as weekly "home visitor" for the client and families, performs para-professional level social work services in cases that require the flexible use of broad social work skills; explain and promote program goals and encourage client's participation in the Interconception Care Home Visiting (ICHV) Program, establish with client the pace of interactions as well as identify the criteria for adjusting intensity and interventions, assist the family assessment worker and program manager in providing "peer group" program activities as well as attend sessions; serve as primary support team member for the ICHV program manager and family assessment worker

Requirements: Full-time; Associate's Degree and one year related experience; or, counseling in a human services field, prior experience working with diverse families in Baltimore City; experience with infant mortality/loss; grief counseling principals, flexible schedule evenings, some Saturdays; experience in use of Microsoft Office; background check and valid driver's license
