



Worried about your baby? We can help.

Are you worried that your baby has delays in learning, speech, movement or interacting with others? The Baltimore Infants & Toddlers Program (BITP) offers free services for children up to age 3 who have developmental delays.

1

Call us to make an appointment to have your child evaluated. Your appointment will be scheduled within six weeks. We can do the evaluation in your home or you can bring your child to BITP or a community site.

2

Connect with a Service Coordinator

One of our service coordinators will call you before the appointment to learn about your child's history and answer any of your questions.

3

Get Your Baby Checked

We will assess your child's skills and development and let you know if your child is eligible for BITP.

IF YES: Your service coordinator will develop an Individual Family Service Plan with you.

IF NO: Your child doesn't need BITP services right now. But you can call BITP again if you are still worried.

If your child joins BITP—

4

Start Services

Services will begin within a month. We can come to your home or your child's daycare, or you can bring your child to BITP.

5

Give Feedback

Your service coordinator will call or visit you every month to see how your baby is doing. You'll review and update your child's plan every six months.

6

Plan for Next Steps

Services usually end at age 3. Your service coordinator will help you to make a plan for what happens next. Some children are eligible to stay in BITP up to age 4.
